"Checks & Balances"

U.S. Const., Art. 1, Sec. 10, Cl. 1; "No State shall enter into any Treaty, Alliance, or Confederation; grant Letters of Marque and Reprisal; coin Money; emit Bills of Credit; make any Thing but gold and silver Coin a Tender in Payment of Debts; pass any Bill of Attainder, ex post facto Law, or Law impairing the Obligation of Contracts, or grant any Title of Nobility."

There can be no law made at the State or Federal level which would have the power to repeal or over-ride the above prohibitions and force this change upon the public. The Amendment process is the Law and must be followed. The "Legal Tender Statutes" are UNCONSTITUTIONAL!!!!
